Issue Description:	Overview of the requirements: The Operator shall document the downstream treatment chain of WEEE and fractions thereof as long as they have not reached the end-of-waste status. The Operator shall document the downstream treatment chain e.g. for: - Batteries, - Hazardous waste,
	 Capacitors, Non pure fractions that represent more than 20% (e.g., rest of appliances). Question:
	Is for batteries that are handed over from the Operator to a specialized collective scheme required a full documentation of downstream treatment chain as long as they have not reached the end-of-waste status? - See the questions 10 and 11 in the A04TR Auditor Manual.
WEEELABEX Organisation Statement	For batteries that are handed over to a specialized/authorized collective scheme it is not required any additional full documentation of downstream treatment chain as long as they have not reached the end-of-waste status (however, the full downstream monitoring is preferred where possible). However, the auditor shall evaluate whether this kind of handing over the batteries to a collective scheme is in compliance with the local legislation and the permit requirements or not. Moreover, a permit/licence of the specialized collective scheme must be available.
